# Australian Army Cadets Enrolment

### Aim of cadet training

The aim of cadet training is to, by predominantly voluntary effort, better equip young people for community life by fostering initiative, discipline and loyalty through training programs which are also designed to stimulate an interest in the services.

### Cadet obligation

- A cadet is expected to attend all home training parades held by the unit.
- A cadet is expected to attend the cadet unit scheduled bivouacs and annual camp.
- Cadets are expected to maintain their uniform in good repair and to wear the uniform with pride.

### Fitness

In the interests of all concerned, applicants are to be examined by a medical practitioner who is to record any restrictions, that are to apply to participation in activities, on form AC782-1 - Medical Examination Record.

### Service in the Australian Defence Force

Acceptance into the Australian Army Cadets does not infer that the applicant will be suitable for acceptance into the Australian Defence Force at a later date.
